CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION:

- Must be a member in good standing.
- The exhibit spot is offered at no cost to member.
- Member may pass out brochures, collect leads, conduct game or activity or sell product(s) or services.
- Exhibit may not exceed 10'x10'. Member must bring own table/chairs/power source.
- Members may participate twice during the Fremont Street Eats season. Fremont Street Eats ends Friday, November 2, 2012 providing
 weather permits.
- There is currently a maximum of two (2) spots per week.
- We conduct a weekly drawing at the event and participating members are encouraged to donate a raffle prize to further their promotional efforts.
- Members are responsible for the clean-up of their own space as well as garbage disposable. Members are required to make a cleaning deposit of \$100. Should member exhibit area be left clean, deposit will be returned.
- With the exception of member restaurants, members are not allowed to provide food or beverage of any type, this includes wrapped candy.
- Member restaurants may participate by providing food, however, they are responsible for obtaining a temporary health permit for special events. There is no BBQ or cooking of any kind allowed. In accordance with Health Department regulations, food may only be served within a covered and screened facility.
- No animals or balloons are permitted.
